Reason: ABRA is announcing Mississippi & DC's Patient Reciprocity and detailing the guidelines when encountering an out of state patient.		

Greetings Metrc Users,

Effective June 1, patients enrolled in Mississippi's medical cannabis program are eligible to purchase up to 8-ounces of cannabis from [DC's seven \(7\) licensed dispensaries](#) when visiting the nation's capital.

To date, reciprocity has been extended to [patients registered in 38 U.S. state and territory medical cannabis programs, including Maryland and Virginia](#).

Eligible DC nonresident patients must present their state or territory-issued registration and photo identification to purchase cannabis.

DC residents may continue to enroll in the District's program at no cost through August 18, 2022, and applicants older than 65 years of age may self-certify in lieu of securing a recommendation from their healthcare provider through September 30.
