



## NEW WASTE REPORTING OPTIONS

When reporting waste in Harvests, you will now have a dropdown list to choose the waste type being reported. The state will configure the waste types from which you will choose.

## Metrc Support Bulletin

You will now have the options below in the Waste Types:

- Plant Material– Normal harvest waste
- Fibrous Waste – Stalks and stems intended for recycling
- Root Ball (Enter as quantity not weight) – Quantity of in-tact root balls intended for recycling. Use quantity, e.g. “1” root ball and leave unit of measure so the root ball does not cause Harvest Weight to go into negative.

*Please note: If Fibrous Waste and Root Ball material **will not** be sold to a recycling company, Plant Material can be used for all Harvest Waste.*
