This bulletin provides notice to all licensees of upcoming changes to CCTT-Metrc. These changes include:

- Restrictions on the types of products that each license type can receive in a transfer based on the *Item Category* of the package. This change is scheduled to occur on 01/19/2021.
- An update to the *Item Categories* available for capsule products. **This change is** scheduled to occur on 12/15/2020.

Descriptions of these upcoming changes are provided in the sections below.

### Restrictions to the Types of Products that Can Be Received




Figure 1: Item Category on Packages Grid

The *Item Category* of a package is displayed on the *Packages* grid as shown in **Figure 1** below.

CCTT-Metrc will be reconfigured on **01/19/2021** to only allow licensees to receive packages with the *Item Categories* allowed for their license type, as outlined in Appendix A below.

All manufactured product intended to be transferred to a Distributor or Retailer, and all flower intended to be transferred to a Retailer, must be packaged using an *Item Category* with a *Unit of Measure* of **each**. Manufactured product packaged using a *Unit of Measure* of bulk weight or volume will no longer be able to be transferred to a Distributor or Retailer. In addition, flower packages with a *Unit of Measure* of bulk weight (i.e. grams or pounds) will no longer be able to be transferred to a Retailer.

This configuration change will impact the ability to transfer some packages. When registering a new transfer or editing an existing transfer on or after 01/19/2021, an error message will display if a package in the transfer cannot be received by the destination license based on the *Item Category*. If an error message is received, the transfer manifest will not be able to be completed and the cannabis goods may not be transferred.




Figure 2: Error Message When Destination Licensee Cannot Receive Package Based on Item Category

In **Figure 2** below, a licensee receives an error message when attempting to register a new transfer to a Retailer (BCC Type 9 or Type 10 license) which includes the package with an *Item Category* of *Flower* shown in **Figure 1**. Regulations prohibit bulk flower from being transferred to retail, and, per Appendix A, Retailers are unable to receive an *Item Category* of *Flower*.

To complete the transfer to retail in the example above, the bulk *Flower* package must be repackaged in CCTT-Metrc using an *Item* associated to an *Item Category* that can be received by Retailers, such as *Flower* (packaged eighth - each). See *Repackaging to Correct Item Category* section below.

Any pending transfers at the time this change is implemented can be completed, even if some of the packages contain products restricted under the updated configuration change. However, if a licensee needs to edit such a transfer, they will need to remove any restricted packages from the transfer in order to proceed or void the transfer.



#### **Repackaging to Correct Item Category**

If you have product in your inventory for an intended recipient but it is assigned the incorrect *Item Category* in CCTT-Metrc, the product can be electronically repackaged to assign the appropriate *Item Category*.

Below are the steps you can take at the time of transfer or on a proactive basis to ensure the product is transferable to the intended recipient.

#### 1. Add Item.

Before repackaging, the necessary *Item* must already be included in your *Item List*. If the *Item* is not already set-up, please refer to section 2.6.2.1 of the *Metrc Industry User's Guide- CA Supplemental* to ensure proper creation of the *Item* for your inventory.




Figure 3: Add Each Item for Repackaging Bulk Product

Figure 3 below demonstrates the creation of an *Item* associated with an *Item Category* of *Flower (packaged eighth - each)*. In this example the licensee entered an *Item Name* of "Skywalker Flower (eighth)" to describe their inventory and chose *Flower (packaged eighth - each)* from the *Item Category* drop down menu.

#### 2. Repackage Product.

When the appropriate *Item* is available in your *Item List*, you can repackage the product to assign the correct *Item Category*.




Figure 4: Repackaging Bulk Flower to Each Packages

For example, if a Distributor is transferring 448 grams of flower to retail consisting of 120 1/8th units and 28 1 gram units, the Distributor electronically repackages the bulk *Flower* package using *Items* associated to *Item Categories* of *Flower* (packaged eighth each) and *Flower* (packaged gram - each) and indicates the number of 'each' (or units) for the two new packages. **Figure 4** below demonstrates this electronic repackaging example using previously added *Items*.

**Important:** When repackaging a product that has previously passed regulatory compliance testing, do **NOT** mark the *Production Batch* checkbox. Doing so will set the *Lab Testing State* on the child packages to "NotSubmitted", severing all test results, again preventing the transfer to retail. Once the test results are severed, they will **not** be re-connected.



## **Updates to Item Categories for Capsules**

Currently, when setting up a new *Item* in CCTT-Metrc for capsule products, there is only one *Item Category* to choose from: *Capsule*.




Figure 5: Adding an Item Using an Item Category of Capsule

On **12/15/2020** the current *Capsule Item Category* will be renamed to *Capsule (weight – each)* to better describe the quantity measurements required when using this *Item Category*. When *Capsule (weight – each)* is selected as the *Item Category*, the *Unit of Measure* must be set to *Each* and a *Unit Weight* must be entered as shown in **Figure 5** below.

If you are currently using the *Capsule Item Category*, the rename to *Capsule (weight – each)* requires no action on your part, as it already requires that the quantity of units be tracked for each package assigned to this *Item Category*.

In addition, on **12/15/2020** a new *Item Category* will be made available that can be used when setting up an *Item* to be used for bulk-manufactured packages of capsules: *Capsule (weight)*.




Figure 6: Adding an Item Using an Item Category of Capsule (weight)

When using the new *Capsule (weight) Item Category*, the *Unit of Measure* must be set to a weight-based measurement as shown in **Figure 6** below.
