Greetings Metrc Users,

On November 3<sup>rd</sup>, the Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) Board announced the extension of reciprocity to medical cannabis patients from Georgia and Iowa, increasing the number of U.S. states and territories whose registrations the District recognizes to 36.

All DC patients and non-resident patients extended reciprocity may purchase medical cannabis in-person or for delivery or curbside pickup (as offered) from any of DC's seven (7) licensed dispensaries. This permission does not extend to non-resident caregivers.

To purchase, non-resident patients must present their government-issued digital or physical registration and photo ID.
