Greetings Metric Users,

Metric is pleased to provide information on our newest enhancements within the software. These enhancements, fixes, or document updates include:

- I. Tissue Culture Plant Batches
- II. Restricting Multi-Destination Transfer Manifests to Display only the Destination License Viewing the Manifest
- III. Added Source Harvest Field to the Transfer Grid and Manifest

Please find on the following pages a detailed description of the enhancements:

Tissue Culture Plant Batches

Cultivation licenses will now see when creating immature plant batches, there is a new option for “Tissue Culture” plant batch types.

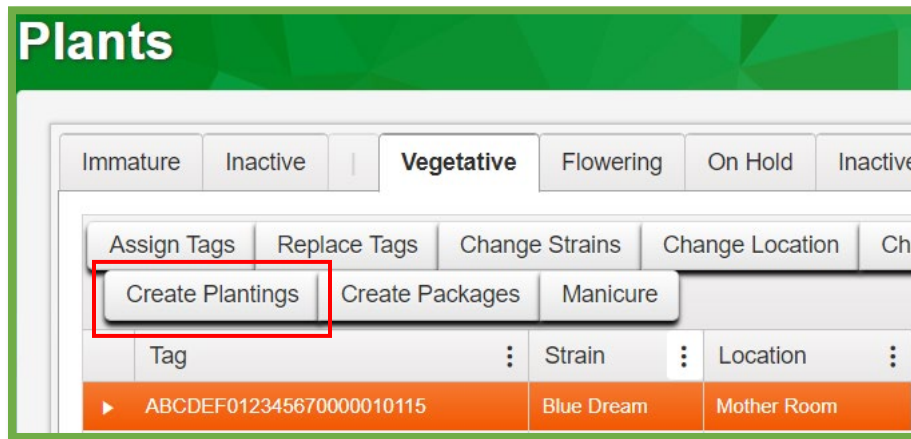


Figure 1: Select Source Plant and Create Planting

To use this new immature plant batch type, follow the same process to create the immature plant batch, by selecting the source plant and selecting the “Create Plantings” button. This step is shown below in **Figure 1**.





Figure 2: Create Tissue Culture Planting Action Window

This button will trigger an action window to enter all the information for the new immature plant batch. There is now the addition of the “Tissue Culture” plant batch type. Once all the information is entered and verified as accurate, utilize the “Create Plantings” button to complete the process. This step is shown in **Figure 2**, below.

Multi-Destination Transfer Manifests

There is the ability to view manifests for transfers being received once created by the shipping license. Shipping licenses can create multi-destination transfers if the transporter is completing multiple transfers in a single trip. However, now receiving licensees will only see the license they are viewing the manifest under as a destination.

To create a multi-destination transfer, at the shipping facility, create the transfer then use the blue “+” button to add multiple destinations. This button is shown below in **Figure 3**.




Figure 4: Create Multi-Destination Transfer Action Window

This button will trigger the additional destination to the transfer action window and then enter all the required information for the second destination. Once complete, utilize the green “Register Transfer” button to complete the process. This step is demonstrated below in **Figure 4**.

Once the transfer is registered, the ability to view the manifests that are outgoing and incoming to the facility will be available.

Please Note: At receiving facilities of a multi-destination transfer, a licensee will only be able to view the entry for the transfer incoming to that specific facility under which the manifest was viewed.

Source Harvest Field for Transfers

Metrc has added the source harvest field of packages being transferred so it can be viewed within the transfer drill down and the transfer manifest. To view the source harvest of a package in a transfer, navigate to the licensed transfer screen and drill down on the transfer, then the destination to view the package information will now display the source harvest. This is shown below in **Figure 5**.
