Greetings Metrc Users-

With the onboarding of the Medical licenses into Metrc, additional guidance is being provided for collocated Medical and Adult-Use licensed facilities under the direction of the Cannabis Control Commission (CCC):

Medical Licensee Metrc Presentations


Transfers

The CCC will allow for transfers between medical and adult-use licenses without any restriction on amount or frequency. To transfer product between adult-use and medical licenses, a transfer manifest






must be created in Metrc. To do this, first go to the licensed transfer page which can be reached by selecting licensed option under the Transfers tab on the top navigational bar.




Next, select "New Transfer" and add all the package(s), planned route, departure time, arrival time, licensed facility performing the transfer, as well as the agent and vehicle information for the transfer. If the transfer is between licenses in a collocated facility, then the only planned route information needs to input for planned route is "Collocated facility".







After the transfer is created, it will no longer be included under the source license inventory. It will immediately appear under the "Incoming" tab in Licensed Transfers at the receiving facility. Upon physically receiving the product, the "Receive" button for the transfer should be selected. Then, ensure that the product listed on the manifest is correct. Once the product information has been verified, select the "Receive Transfer" button.



Sales

Collocated retailers are required to record **consumer sales** under the **Adult-Use** retailer license and all **patient sales** under the **Medical** retailer license. In order to record sales under a retailer license, there must be an inventory supporting those sales. To this end, **to record both Medical and Adult-Use sales the licensee must maintain an adequate inventory to support the sales under both Medical and Adult-Use retail licenses.**
