Reason: Metrc is providing the Product Category Requirement chart with updated instruction from the MMCC.				

Greetings Metrc Users,

Per the MMCC, Pathogen testing has a zero-tolerance level for Listeria monocytogenes, STEC, and Salmonella in the state of Maryland. If upon initial testing the product fails for Salmonella, Listeria Monocytogenes, or STEC, then there is not an option to retest. The product automatically is a test failed. This failed product for pathogen cannot be remediated.

The Licensee and the Testing Facility should notify the MMCC after the initial test is shown to be positive for one of the Pathogens. The product needs to be destroyed, and the area needs to be decontaminated. If the product is found positive for one of the Pathogens on the initial testing then it a test failed automatically. The facility should notify MMCC for the next steps as soon as possible.



Product Category Requirements

The MMCC and Metrc have constructed a chart that accurately defines the required testing for the available Product Categories in the Metrc software. The **left column** displays where the product should be in its lifecycle. The **middle column** will list the available item categories for the stage of the product. The **right column** contains the required testing for the product in the corresponding row. Licensees who need assistance interpreting the data below in **Figure 1**, should contact Metrc support for further assistance.
