## Greetings Metrc Users,

The Medical Marijuana Control Program (MMCP), pursuant to authority in Ohio Revised Code/Ohio Administrative Code 3796, is providing guidance on the use of the Metrc Lab Test Batches. Effective **March 28**, **2022**, licensees will be required to use **revised**, **standardized** Lab Test Batches when submitting medical marijuana for laboratory testing in Metrc.

Metrc Bulletin 35 highlights all the Lab Test Batches that are now available in Metrc to streamline testing requirements.

There is now an additional Lab Test Batch that can be selected for R&D purposes.


Test Batch	Test Type

This Test Batch should be selected what testing for analytes that are not currently already listed under "R&D Testing," such as a plant virus test, or plant nutrient testing.
