
Greetings Metrc Users,

This bulletin is intended to clarify the process for combining two different strains together to create a "Hybrid" strain, also known as Cross-pollination. This process may also apply to those who want to blend trim together.

Hybrid Strains & Blending Trim

First, create the new Strain and Item in their respective areas under the "Admin" tab.

When you are ready to create a new package of your combined product ("blended" or "mixed" shake trim, etc.) highlight the packages you intend to combine and select "New Package".




In the "New Packages" area, as seen on the next page:


- The box labelled "Production Batch" must be checked.
- The box labelled "Production Batch Number" must be filled out.
 - Please include the following information in the Production Batch Number:
 - The license type where it was created (C=Cultivation, P=Production)
 - The name of the strains that were combined
 - The date they were combined
 - Acronyms and/or abbreviations are acceptable in the "Production Batch Number" field (I.E. C-GARK AK47 12/31/18)




