

Reason: To inform Licensees of upcoming changes when creating test samples and designating the Required Test Batches UPDATE		

As of April 4th, 2022, the State of Missouri has changed the configuration of Lab Test Batches to better assist licensed facilities and labs in choosing the correct product category and required test per 19 CSR 30-95.070. This change means that one lab test batch will be selected when creating a test sample based on the product type of the item of the source package that was sampled and is being tested. The Non-Solvent Lab Test Batch has been removed and now when testing any inhalable or concentrate product users will select Inhalable & Concentrates seen in **Figure 1**.
