Reason: Metrc has added the ability to designate THC and CBD percentages within each item that a licensee creates.				

Item Categories Updated in DC

The District of Columbia has decided to implement some updates to the item categories within Metrc. <u>Seven days</u> after the release of this bulletin, Concentrate (Each) will become an Infused Concentrate (Each). Metrc and the Department of Health have also provided examples of what the District expects certain products to be designated as within this item category. Additionally, the Infused (non-edible) category will be updated to Infused Topical (non-edible), and the Buds category will now be Flower/Buds. With these updates nothing will need to be recreated within your items of Metrc. This change will automatically be associated to the items that have been created under each licensee's initial item categories. For industry users that have a third-party vendor for integration, please make sure they are aware of these updates to the item categories.

- Flower/Buds
- Concentrate
 - o Examples: Shatter, Wax, Hash, Pull Snap, and Budder
- Infused Concentrate (Each)
 - o Examples: Vape Pen Cartridges, Tinctures, Capsules, Oils, and Syringes
- Immature Plants
- Infused (edible)
 - o Examples: Butter, Chocolate, Brownies, Cookies, and Granola Bars
- Infused Topical (non-edible)
 - o Examples: Balm, Cream, Spray, Mud, Bath Salts, Lotions, and Ointments
- Keif
- Seeds
 - For Cultivation Center storage purposes only. The District of Columbia doesn't allow the transfer of seeds.
- Shake/Trim Used for combining Shake/Trim (by Strain) packages for extraction

Item Categories Configuration Update

Metrc has added the ability for a licensee within their items to designate the THC and CBD percentage for each item. With this additional piece being added, the Department of Health will allow **SEVEN DAYS** after the release of this bulletin for each Cultivation Center and Dispensary to update **ALL** of their items within Metrc to include the THC and CBD percentages. Moving forward, any item that is created within Metrc will require the THC and CBD percentage to be entered.

Below is an example of what an edit to an item designated as buds will look like within Metrc.

Examples of Items

In Metrc licensees will be creating many different items to meet the needs of their business. Both the Cultivation Centers and Dispensaries need to be aware of how creating items in Metrc affect patient limits. In the District of Columbia, a patient is granted 4 ounces of medical marijuana on a rolling thirty-day basis. This means if Patient A purchases 3 ounces on 5/1 and 1 ounce on 5/10, then they wouldn't be able to purchase any more products until 5/31, and at that point their available amount is back to 3 ounces.

In order to successfully capture these limits in the sales section of Metrc, it is essential to have correct items with the weight properly associated. If a Dispensary is selling individual brownies that equate to five grams of medical marijuana within each brownie, then their item will match the image below.

Some notes on this item. A Metrc package tag will be associated to the entire batch of brownies, in which the weight and cannabinoid profile are the same for all brownies. So, if a Cultivation Center has made a production batch of fifty brownies, only one Metrc package tag would be associated to that production batch. For a Dispensary, this means each sale of one brownie would deduct from that package tag and affect the patients limit by five grams.



Now if the Dispensary decides that they would like to sell a five pack of the same weighted brownies instead of an individual brownie from the example above, a new item will need to be created. The screenshot below shows how this will look in Metrc. Notice that now a one each sale will deduct the total of five brownies versus the previous example of an individual brownies. This will ensure the proper weight being sold is captured when a patient is making a purchase.

Formula: 5 Grams per Brownie * 5 Brownies in Pack = 25 Grams Unit Weight



If a Dispensary plans to sell brownies with different medical marijuana weight amounts that will affect patient limits, they will need to make multiple items, or purchase from the Cultivation Center who should be creating these items with patient purchases in mind. So, the image below would show what would need to be created if the marijuana contained within a brownie being sold was 2.5 grams. Although it is still a brownie at the same Dispensary the different marijuana weight amount within the brownie will need to be properly captured.
