## Revised Package Adjustment Reasons

The State will be revising the list of reasons allowed when making Package adjustments. See the updated list below:

Reason	Direction to the Industry
<b>Contaminant Testing</b>	This is used when a portion of the package will be removed by a Testing Facility to be used in the testing process
<b>Potency Testing</b>	This is used when a portion of the package will be removed by a Testing Facility to be used in the testing process
<b>Proficiency Testing</b>	This is used when a portion of the package will be removed by a Testing Facility to be used in the testing process
<b>Product Re-form</b>	Used when a portion of a batch becomes unusable, the marijuana product will be "re-formed" in a subsequent batch. For example, a chocolate bar breaks and is going to be melted down and the chocolate will be included in the next batch, the unit for the bar is adjusted down.
<b>Processing Loss</b>	The loss of weight as a result of a process. For example, when creating pre-rolls and there is marijuana crumbling into pieces that cannot be collected.
<b>Overpulled</b>	Too much product was placed in the metrc package resulting in more product remaining in originating package than is reflected in Metrc. Requires a note indicating the corresponding package
<b>Underpulled</b>	Too little product was placed in the metrc package resulting in more product being in the new package than is reflected in metrc. Requires a note indicating the corresponding package

<b>Moisture Weight Change</b>	<p>After conducting a physical inventory, moisture loss was observed (Drying) or a moisture increase was observed (rehydrating).</p>
<b>Typing Error</b>	<p>A typing mistake was made with the input of info for the package. For example, entered 100 grams instead of 10 grams. This could include Unit of Measure issues as well. This should not be used instead of correcting sales.</p>
<b>Incorrect Quantity</b>	<p>If a received package in a transfer was not correctly weighed or counted. This should not be used instead of correcting sales. If the package is significantly off it should be rejected.</p>
<b>Oversold</b>	<p>Reported too much product was sold from the package. Requires a note indicating the corresponding package.</p>
<b>Undersold</b>	<p>Underreported sales from the package. Requires a note indicating the corresponding package.</p>
<b>Plants Unpacked</b>	<p>To indicate the planting of immature plants (adjust and report as unpacked)</p>
<b>Theft</b>	<p>MED must be notified and documentation filed with support@metrc.com</p>
<b>Waste (Unusable Marijuana)</b>	<p>Selected to reflect throwing marijuana away because it is unusable as a result of passing expiration dates, formation of mold or mildew, or other spoilage scenarios.</p>
<b>Destruction (Usable marijuana or State/Local Authority Involvement)</b>	<p>Selected when usable product is being thrown away as a result of a state or local authority mandated or supervised process, voluntary surrender of marijuana, response to a Health and Safety Advisory or other similar circumstance.</p>
<b>API Duplicate Sales Entry</b>	<p>When a sales entry has been duplicated by the POS system in Metrc.</p>

<b>API Adjustment Error</b>	When an adjustment is made erroneously in both the API and in Metrc.
<b>API Conversion Error</b>	When amounts are not set up properly or aligned in the POS system and Metrc.
