These enhancements have come from industry requests and will be live on the evening of Monday, April 11th for Reports and “Additional Metrc Changes” additions. On the evening of Tuesday, April 12th the Harvest Batch Test Results functionality will be live. The information below outlines these new additions.

Going Live Monday, April 11th Reports

Package Adjustment Report

You will now have the ability to run a report based on package adjustments. The Package Adjustment report will include date range selection as well as filters for type of adjustment (Adjustment Reason), for item name and by item category, if desired. You may choose to generate the report using any or all of the filters.

The latest transfer report available to you will give you the option to report on any type of transfer, incoming or outgoing, by date range. This report will enable you to filter by any type of transfer, regardless of the designation at the time of creation or receiving. For example: you can select all Infusion Transfers, Regular Transfers, Wholesale Transfers or all three. There is a large amount of information included in this report. Therefore, it is formatted to fit proportionately on a landscape legal-sized print out.

Additional Changes within Metrc

The “**Add Facilities**” functionality will soon be moved from Admin to under the User dropdown. For now, a note has been added to the top of the Facilities page within Metrc.

A new restriction has been added to prevent untagged Vegetative plants from being Manicured. A tag ID will need to be assigned before a Manicure can be performed on Veg plants.

For security purposes, all user badge numbers will have the last three characters masked. So, when viewing any functionality where a user/employee is associated the last three characters will no longer be visible (you will see “●●●”).

Harvest Batch Test Results (Going Live Tuesday, April 12th)

Results from tests performed on Harvest Batches will now follow packages made from a Harvest Batch. As you package from a Harvest and test that product, all packages created from that tested product will show the testing results within the package grid.

- If a package is pulled from a Harvest Batch via the submit for testing package option, subsequent packages pulled from that Harvest Batch will carry the Test Results from the related package.
- Single or Multiple Harvests can be selected to create a “Submit for Testing” package.

Please note: In order for the entire Harvest to carry the results the Test Sample package MUST be made from the Harvest Batches directly and not from a derived package. (Test results will only move “up” one level.)
