

## **Software Update Memorandum**

## \*\*Change To Log-In Protocol\*\*


We would like to alert you of a **significant change** to the User log in process for Metrc. This will be in effect on **Monday, April 18**<sup>th</sup>. The information below outlines this change.

There will now be an additional element required for each User's log-in to the Metrc system. This element will be a **required email address** to be entered in addition to the standard User Name and password currently in effect. The email address entered for log in **MUST** coincide with the **email address used to credential the user/employee into the system**.

The Marijuana Enforcement Division (MED), in conjunction with Franwell, believes this is an important step to further protect the security of each state-badged person's information as well as the data for all business licenses.

Any Metrc User who does not know what email address was used to credential them into the system can find it as shown below. Metrc administrators should help Users from their licenses be ready for the transition on Monday, April 18<sup>th</sup>.

In addition, when a User does not know or remember what email address was used for credentialing; the Metrc Support Team will ONLY execute a password reset and cannot give out the email address.
