
- Transaction Details added to the Record/Edit Deliveries Modal

Additional Sales Delivery Fields

The recent addition of the Transaction Details dropdown that is currently available on the Sales Receipts Record/Edit modals, has now also been added to the Sales Delivery Record/Edit modals. These optional fields allow for more accurate and detailed reporting of sales information collected by the licensee and submitted to their respective State Regulatory Agency. The following is a list of the added fields found in the Transaction Details dropdown:

- Invoice
- Price
- Excise Tax
- City Tax
- County Tax
- Municipal Tax
- Discount Amount
- Subtotal
- Sales Tax
