Reason: New DCC regulations requiring capture of City and Zip Code on Retailer Deliveries				

Greetings,

New Department of Cannabis Control (DCC) regulations have been implemented, which require the capture of both the destination City and Zip Code when recording both planned and unplanned product sales during Retailer Deliveries. This functionality will become effective on January 2, 2024.

A description of where these additional fields can be found within the existing process is provided on the following pages. A detailed description of the related Retailer Deliveries workflows can be found in previous support bulletin <u>CA IB 2022 08, Tracking Retailer</u> <u>Deliveries</u>.



Capturing Destination City and Zip Code in Retailer Deliveries

Capturing the destination City and Zip Code for Retailer Deliveries will occur in one of two areas of the system.

First, for planned deliveries, navigate to the *Record Retailer Deliveries* pop-up window (reference previous bulletin for instructions) – **see Figure 1.**

To enter orders that have been received and processed by the licensed retailer before the driver leaves the licensed premises, add one or more destinations using the add

destination button - Other that will have a unique delivery location.

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This will insert a *Destination* section for selecting the county (pre-existing field), **as well as entering the City and Zip Code** (new fields) where each delivery is to be made – **see Figure 2.**

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Second, the *Sale* button is used to record unplanned sales made from packages in the vehicle on the delivery trip, including selecting the County (pre-existing field), **as well as entering the City and Zip Code** (new fields). The *Record Deliveries* action window appears after the *Sale* button is selected – **see Figure 3**.
