Greetings,

Metrc, in conjunction with the Maryland Cannabis Administration (MCA), is providing clarification regarding cannabis products available for retail sale.

**Correction update:** Effective June 7, 2024, MCA has released permanent regulations under [COMAR 14.17](#) that make certain changes for all licensees. Changes to products available for retail sale are highlighted below. Concentrates may now be sold for adult-use consumers as well as medical patients and caregivers.

Concentrate (Weight)	Medical/Adult Use Consumer
Exempt Edible Product (Medical only)	Medical only
Exempt Liquid Edible Product (Medical only)	Medical only
Infused Edible	Medical /Adult Use Consumer <b>*Must not exceed 10/100mg THC</b>
Infused Edible (Capsule Only)	Medical /Adult Use Consumer <b>*Must not exceed 10/100mg THC</b>
Infused Liquid Edible	Medical /Adult Use Consumer <b>*Must not exceed 10/100mg THC</b>
Infused Non-Edible	Medical /Adult Use Consumer
Seedling	Medical /Adult Use Consumer
Seeds	Medical /Adult Use Consumer
Shake/Trim	Medical /Adult Use Consumer
Shake/Trim (by strain)	Medical /Adult Use Consumer
Tincture for Oral Administration	Medical /Adult Use Consumer <b>*Must not exceed 10/100mg THC</b>
Vape Cart	Medical /Adult Use Consumer
