Metrc is pleased to provide information on the latest system enhancements that will be available on 2/14/2024, including:

- Test Batches Relationships Report Updates
- Metrc Password Requirements

Test Batches Relationships Report

Reports within the Metrc system provide both licensees and the State with data that is used to gain insights into business operations and the industry. The Test Batches Relationships Report is utilized by both State and industry users. For industry users specifically, this report is a great tool to help you understand your compliance with Colorado testing regulations.




Figure 1: Harvest Name Field that has been removed

Previously, this report had two required fields to complete before the report could be generated – Harvest Name and Facility. It was found that by requiring those two fields, the report was not displaying helpful information to the user. As a solution, we have removed the required Harvest Name field – **See Figure 1.**

Metrc Password Requirements

The Metrc password character limit was recently updated from 8 to 9 characters. This means passwords must have a minimum of 9 characters that also meet the standard requirements regarding use of symbols, capital letters, and numbers. This change will take effect upon the user's next password reset.

Additionally, effective 2/14/24, Metrc will prohibit password reuse going back six (6) generations. If a user attempts to reuse a password that was used within the past six generations, they will receive an alert message reading:

"Password must not be the same as the previous 6 passwords."
