<b>Reason:</b> Metrc is providing an update on the addition of the new Suppository Item Category		

Greetings,

Metrc, in conjunction with the MSDH and MSDOR, would like to announce the addition of the “Suppository” item category that will go live on December 15, 2023. This bulletin will walk through the process of creating an item using this new item category.

Suppository sales to medical patients in Mississippi will not count against their daily allotment. If a suppository is sold to a non-patient, enter NOPT000000 in the field requiring a patient number to indicate this is “not a patient.”

Any existing “Topical” suppositories at Dispensaries or manifested and received at Dispensaries before December 31, 2023, will not be required to be repackaged and assigned the new item.


Any products manifested on or after January 1, 2024 will need to be sent as the new “suppository” item.

## **Suppository Item Category**


MSDH MMCP will be creating a new “Suppository” Item Category on December 15, 2023. Once the new Item Category has been enabled, new Items will need to be created utilizing this new Item Category in order to be able to package the product properly. To create a new Item using the Suppository Item Category, select the Items option under the Admin area on the navigational toolbar. This step is shown below in **Figure 1**.

**Please Note:** If you do not see this option, you will need to be granted permission under the employee admin menu.

Once on the Items grid, utilize the “Add items” button to begin the process. This step is demonstrated below in **Figure 2**.

This button will open an action window to enter the item information utilizing the “Suppository” Item Category. Once the information is entered, use the green “Create Items” button to complete the process. This step is demonstrated in **Figure 3**.

Why is there no multi-Facility create such as that available in Employees, Strains, and Locations?  
Certain Item Categories require the selection of a pre-existing Strain. Verifying and informing that the specified Strain exists in all of the selected Facilities would be convoluted and complex to inform. For this reason we have opted to not add the ability to create Items in multiple Facilities at the same time.

Once the item is created, navigate to the packages grid and select the appropriate source package that is being used to create the new Suppository package. Use the “New Packages” button as shown in **Figure 4**.

**Figure 4: Select Source Package & New Packages Button**

This button will open an action window to create the new Suppository package utilizing the new Item name that was previously created. Then indicate the amount taken from the source package on the right-hand side and the new package information on the left-hand side.

Please note that the production batch box should be selected since the new package is a different item category than the previous packages. A production batch number will then need to be assigned. This step is shown in **Figure 5**.
