## Greetings,

On Monday, April 8, 2024, District Mayor Muriel Bowser signed the *Medical Cannabis* Patient Card Extension and 4/20 Medical Cannabis Sales Tax Holiday Week Emergency Amendment Act of 2024. To read more, please visit this <u>website</u>.

Please note the following important information:

- This permanently extends the valid period of medical cannabis patient and caregiver registrations from two (2) years to six (6) years.
- The extension applies only to new registrants and does not retroactively extend to existing registrations.
- Registration remains free for DC-residents, and applicants 21 years of age and older can self-certify.
- Cannabis facilities do not need to take any action.
