Greetings,

Washington D.C.'s Alcoholic Beverage and Cannabis Administration (A.B.C.A) is informing specific medical licensees of an important upcoming name change in Metrc's system:

Effective May 14th, 2025, at 10 a.m. EST, the following facility license numbers in Metrc will change to ABCA assigned facility license numbers.

The changes to the license number will go into effect on the day of implementation and will be immediately registered within Metrc.

Licensees should notify their third-party integrators of the license number change as soon as possible. This should include giving the original license number and the corresponding new license number.

Integrators are third-party, software service providers that interact with Metrc. Integrators may include POS (point-of-sale) providers, ERP or Supply Chain providers, Accounting or Banking providers, etc. If you are unsure of which software providers need to be aware of the change, it is best to reach out to your provider directly.



Note: It is critical that all system Admins verify the license number change on May 14th and notify the appropriate staff of the change.

This license number change should not affect any of the day-to-day reporting in Metrc and log in will remain as normal, however, the new license number will be seen at the top right corner of Metrc when logged in.

License Number Changes – RFID tags

Licensees may continue to use existing RFID tags with the original license number until they are depleted. Tag orders submitted on or after May 14th, 2025, will be printed with the new license number.

Best practice recommendations:

- Use the original tags with the original license number before using any new tags.
- Inform relevant staff of this update and ensure they can differentiate the original license numbers and updated license numbers during this transition.
