

<b>Reason:</b> Decimals available in “Number of Doses” field during item creation.		

Greetings,

On June 4, 2025, licensees will have the ability to enter decimals into the “Number of Doses” field when creating an item. Previously, Metrc only allowed for the entry of whole numbers.

In the Flower example below, if the product’s dose is 1 gram, the licensee should enter 3 and a half (3.5) 1-gram doses into “Number of Doses” field - **see Figure 1.**
