Metrc, in conjunction with the New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory Commission (CRC) are pleased to provide information about a new Item Category and Lab Test Batch for Infused Liquid Edibles that will be available in Metrc on July 2, 2025.

New Item Category: Infused Liquid Edibles

On July 2, 2025 a new Item Category, Infused Liquid Edibles will be available for Adult Use and Medical Manufacturers in New Jersey to use when creating infused liquids edibles.

Note: New items created using the Infused Liquid Edibles Item Category require preapproval by the NJ CRC before they can be used.




Figure 1: Metrc Expert widget in Metrc System

To use the Infused Liquid Edibles Item Category, a new Item will need to be created. For guidance on how to create a new item, please reference the knowledge base in Metrc Expert – **see Figure 1**.

- To access Metrc Expert, log in to Metrc and look for the green circle icon in the bottom right corner.
- Click the green circle icon to expand options and select Reference our Support Guides > Getting Started in Metrc > Start Here to Set Up Your Account > Enter Item Names.
