<b>Reason:</b> The current Bud/Flower item category will be split into 2 new items categories: a weight-based item category (bulk) and a count-based item category (each).		

#### Greetings,

Metrc, in coordination with the NJ CRC, is pleased to provide the following update regarding item categories in Metrc:

- Starting on July 17, 2025, two new item categories will be available in Metrc:
  - o Bud/Flower (bulk) weight-based
  - o Bud/Flower (each) count-based
- Then on October 15, 2025, the existing Bud/Flower item category will be disabled in Metrc.

This change will serve to better classify bulk versus final form plant material, providing greater clarity for licensees and CRC.

Licensees must recreate the items they wish to continue using from the existing Bud/Flower item category into one of the new item categories.

# **New Bud/Flower Item Categories**




Figure 1 – Current Bud/Flower Item Category in Metrc

There is currently one weight-based item category for Bud/Flower available to New Jersey licensees when creating flower items in Metrc – **see Figure 1**.

Beginning on July 17, 2025, licensees will see two new item categories available to create flower items:

- Bud/Flower (bulk)
  - Weight based unit of measure
  - o Used for harvest batches and bulk flower for processing
  - Does not require pre-approval by CRC
- Bud/Flower (each)
  - Count based unit of measure
  - Used for final form flower items (ex: eighth jars, 7g bags)
  - Does not require pre-approval by CRC




Figure 2 – Metrc Expert widget in Metrc System, Reference Our Support Guides

Licensees must recreate existing flower items that they intend to use going forward by adding new items into the new item categories by October 15, 2025. For guidance on how to create a new item in Metrc, please reference the knowledge base in Metrc Expert – see Figure 2.

- To access Metrc Expert, log in to Metrc and look for the circle icon with the Metrc crest in the bottom right corner.
- Click the circle icon to expand options and select Reference Our Support Guides
  Getting Started in Metrc > Start Here to Set Up Your Account > Enter Item
  Names

Existing items in the Bud/Flower item category should be discontinued once new items have been built.

Packages made from the items that have been discontinued will still be transferable and sellable after October 15, 2025.



# **Frequently Asked Questions**

Are the same fields required when creating items in the new Bud/Flower item categories?

- Yes, for the Bud/Flower (bulk) item category.
- No, for the Bud/Flower (each) item category. This item category will require Unit CBD and Unit THC percentages to be entered.

Do I have to repackage items from the Bud/Flower (bulk) item category into the Bud/Flower (each) item category before transferring to a Dispensary for sale?

Yes.

Do I have to conduct state compliance testing on items in the Bud/Flower (bulk) item category?

- No. Whether the licensee chooses to conduct state compliance testing or R&D testing on bulk items is a business decision.
- State compliance testing is required for items in the Bud/Flower (each) item category because final form items being transferred to Dispensaries for sale must have a test passed or retest passed status.
