<b>Reason:</b> Provide guidance to the industry for a consistent naming convention for their harvest and manicure batches.		

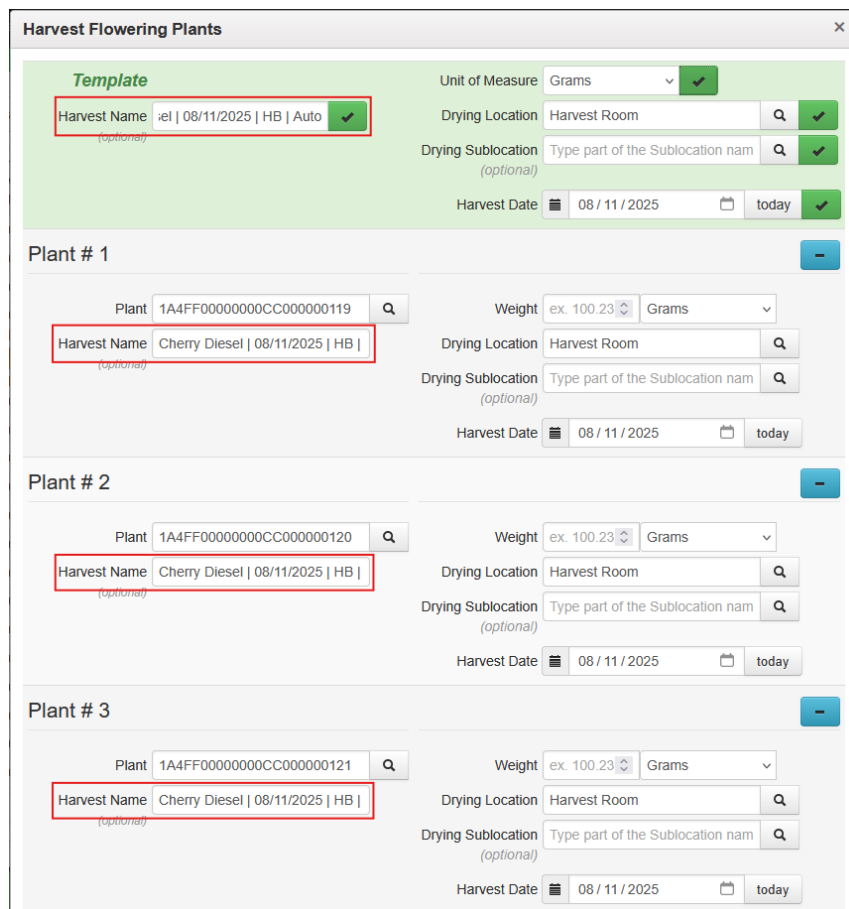
Greetings,

A new harvest and manicure batch naming convention will be required for Cultivators to use when creating new harvest and manicure batches in Metrc. This is intended to help businesses stay aligned with the OCM's new naming standards by reducing room for error.

### **Required Harvest/Manicure Batch Naming Convention:**

**“Plant Strain Name | Date of Harvest or Manicure | HB or MB | Auto or Photo”**

For example, if a batch of Cherry Diesel Auto were harvested on 08/11/2025, the newly required harvest batch name would be: **Cherry Diesel | 08/11/2025 | HB | Auto.**



## Definitions:

- **Harvest Batch:** a collection of plants harvested on the same day and share the same strain
- **Manicure Batch:** portions of a plant are harvested, while the remainder stays in the ground. Each manicure batch is associated with a single day's harvest activity and strain specificity should be maintained.
- **Auto Flower:** cannabis plant variety that automatically switches from vegetative to flowering growth stage based on age
- **Photoperiod Plant Flower:** cannabis plant variety where life cycle phases (vegetative growth and bloom) are controlled by the frequency and length of time the plants receive light

*Please note: The naming convention of harvest/manicure batches are different from item naming for products set up in Metrc.*
