Reason: To provide a Staged Packages feature enhancement update as it relates to optional Metrc Retail ID functionality.		

Greetings,

This bulletin applies only to licensees who are utilizing the optional Metrc Retail ID functionality

Starting in August, the new Staged Packages feature will enable those who label – accros Cultivation and Manufacturing– with the ability to generate Metrc Retail ID QR codes earlier in the production process. This feature will allow users with "Manage Product Labels" permissions to:

- Generate Retail IDs for packages that are not yet active in Metrc inventory
- Manage finished good packages more effectively—especially licensed businesses with unique packaging requirements, like labeling flat, unfilled packages.
- Integrate Staged Packages into existing labeling workflows—eliminating the need for workflow modifications.
- Print Retail ID QR codes without adjusting for final quantities—making it more efficient and flexible.

A new "Staged Product Labels" tab has been added next to the existing Product Labels tab. When ready, users can activate these packages through the current process using the New Package tab.
