As our organization continues to innovate to better meet the needs of our state agency partners and industry users, please read on for important updates.

Under the agreement established between the Cannabis Regulatory Agency (CRA) and Metrc, and due to recent changes in the market, the following price changes will go into effect **beginning October 1, 2025**:

- Plant tags will change to \$0.46 per plant tracked
- Package tags will change to \$0.26 per package tracked
