Greetings,

Metrc, in conjunction with the Nevada CCB, is pleased to announce the launch of the **Product Catalog** which will provide the public with a comprehensive database of regulated cannabis products sold through licensed Retail Stores, Medical Stores, and Consumption Lounges in the State of Nevada.

Update as of October 6th – At this time we will not include Tribal Dispensaries.

The **Nevada CCB Product Catalog** feature went live on Monday, October 6, 2025. However, it is not expected to be fully functional until **October 12, 2025**. To ensure transparency and compliance with **NRS 678B.635**, the Cannabis Compliance Board (CCB) has partnered with Metrc to implement a retail-level product catalog database for cannabis and cannabis products. This catalog provides detailed product information and certificate of analysis data, promoting regulatory transparency and supporting the safe consumption of cannabis in Nevada's regulated market.

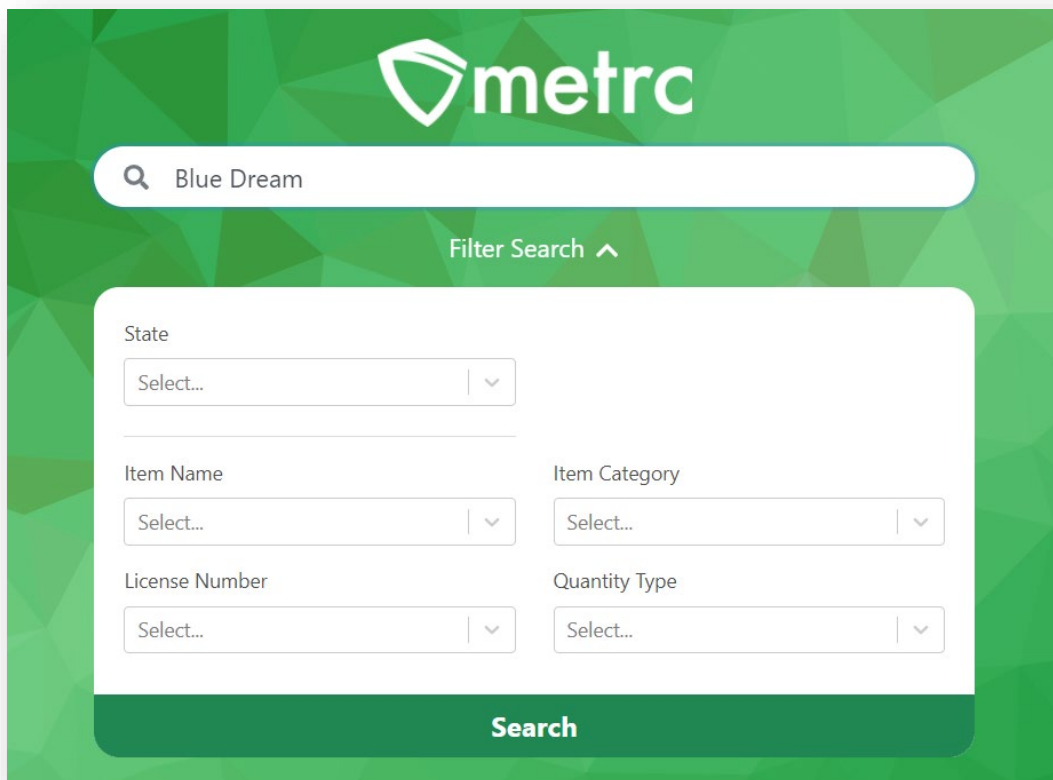

Searching the Product Catalog

The Product Catalog can be accessed directly at <https://catalog.metrc.com/> at the time of the effective date of October 6, 2025.

Visitors accessing the catalog can search by entering product information into the search bar and selecting filter criteria - **see Figure 1**.

Products that will be searchable in the Catalog

The following list of categories assigned to product items will be published in the online catalog after being transferred to state-licensed retail stores.

All facilities must review their Items to ensure that items destined for sale to a consumer or patient are properly categorized, particularly when repacking bulk items into a sellable form. The following are examples of products that are destined for sale at the retail level.
