On December 23, 2025, a new item category will be available for use within the New York Metrc environment:

Infused Flower – Each

Please utilize the new item categories when creating infused flower final form products.

Also, there will be 2 new lab test batches that correlate with the new item category. Those lab test batches are:

AU Infused Flower – Final Form

Medical Infused Flower – Final Form

Please utilize the appropriate lab test batch when creating infused flower final form test sample packages.
