Admins – Set up business account in Metrc with required info

- Package UID, Retail Item ID orders and adding Employees must be completed in Metrc.
- All other account setup actions can occur through the Metrc API via third-party systems or completed in Metrc.
 - **Note:** *Your API key must be generated in Metrc to use the API to complete these actions.*

External Incoming Transfers

All beginning inventory needs to be brought into your license to ensure your Metrc electronic inventory matches your physical inventory on hand using the two step External Incoming Transfers process.

Both steps must be completed for the tracked packages to be reflected in your Metrc inventory:

- **Step 1:** Creating an External Incoming Transfer can be completed through the Metrc API via third-party systems to push the initial inventory into the system in batches (or manually in the Metrc system.)
- **Step 2:** Receiving the External Incoming Transfer must be done manually in the Metrc system.

Product testing: All beginning inventory will have a testing status of *Not Submitted*.

- *Example 1:* If you are bringing in product that has not yet been tested, use the standard testing process (*reference the New Business Fundamentals training for details*).
- *Example 2:* Move all tested product(s) out of active inventory and over to the distributor prior to bringing in your beginning inventory so it can be sold.
- *Example 3:* For existing inventory that has already been placed in its final packaging and has already completed compliance testing, follow the electronic sampling process.



Ordering Metrc Plant and/or Package UIDs

All ordering occurs in Metrc.



- Place separate orders for each facility as they are programmed for each facility's account individually.
- Make sure that you are in the correct facility within Metrc when you place the order.
- Orders are *not* transferable between facilities.

Retail Item ID

What is Retail Item ID?

Retail Item ID is a **digital unique identifier for each unit of Finished Good products** that, when scanned with a supported device, provides supplemental product information, such as **origin and test results**, ultimately increasing **consumer confidence and public awareness for regulated cannabis sales**.



Unit tracking with Retail Item ID

A digital ID for individual unit product labels to enhance supply chain visibility and drive operational efficiency.

✓ Important information



In New York, once the beginning inventory period closes (December 17th) all cannabis products transferred to distributor facilities must be designated as a Finished Good package with a Retail Item ID applied to each unit **before transfer to distributors.**

This enables seamless product identification and intake at retail, extends product recalls to individual units, and improves consumer safety and visibility during product purchasing.

Retail Item IDs are ordered in Metrc and individually deducted when used in a finished good package.

Retail Item ID – Benefits for Processors

Unprecedented access to real-time market performance data and expanded storytelling capabilities.

Legitimacy & safety verification

QR codes provide verified compliance data, allowing consumers to confirm products are legal, lab-tested, and safe.

Brand protection

Additional counterfeit protection via clear presentation of authenticity and safety details helps consumers avoid illicit products and builds trust.

Supply chain transparency

Interactive QR codes offer access to test results and COAs, meeting regulatory requirements.

Enhanced consumer engagement

Ability to enrich product details with digital content (images, videos, calls to action) to boost brand recognition.

How to order Retail Item IDs

- 1 Go to “Retail Item ID” in the Metrc Admin menu.
- 2 Click “New Retail Item ID Order” to begin a new order.
- 3 Enter the count needed along with other required information.

Requirements

- 1 Must have Retail Item IDs to create a Finished Good Package.
- 2 When a Finished Good Package is created, Retail Item IDs will be automatically generated to the total quantity of the package if they had not previously been generated before the package became a finished good.
- 3 Creating a Package from a Finished Good Package will carry the designation of a Finished Good Package. No additional Retail Item IDs will be recorded.
- 4 Transfers to Distribution after Beginning Inventory will be required to be a Finished Good Package.


Retail Item ID workflow – Processors

Initial package created from a Harvest Batch.

Optional - Repackage original flower material into separate bulk categories.

Repackage into Finished Goods and download Retail Item IDs for each specific product SKU. You must mark it as a Finished Good and it must have TestPassed or RetestPassed testing status in order to be transferred to a Distributor.




Retail Item ID workflow – Distributors



- 1** Distributors will receive packages with Retail Item IDs already applied to individual units.
- 2** In Metrc, repackage using current process for planned deliveries. Package tags can be used as the "Case Pack".
- 3** Transfer package(s) to select dispensaries
- 4** Dispensaries receive package(s) in Metrc. Note: POS integrates with Metrc to sync Retail Item IDs with packages, pending vendor's integration capabilities.

Metrc tracked inventory credits

New York UID credit process per OCM

Metrc applied an allotment credit to Plant UID, Package UID, or Retail Item IDs for select license types.

- You must be credentialed and have your business set up to order your Plant or Package allotment or access your auto-credited Retail Item ID allotment.
- If you received an allotment credit, your Admin received an email from noreply@metrc.com
- These do not expire and can be used at any time.
- When the allotment has been exhausted, licensees must purchase by ordering in the Metrc system.


Processing Jobs

When creating a group/batch of a specific product type, you may have more than one Production Batch in a Processing Job.

Example: A single day or week

Production Batch

A specific Production Batch of products produced for a specific day. *Example: A batch or brownies baked during a specific day using the same oil and ingredients from the processing job.*

Processing jobs vs.
repackaging update

Bulk testing

- ✓ Is allowed for oil (vape carts).
- ✓ Is allowed for bulk flower material if it is intended to be packaged and sold as flower.

Use case example

For a vape cart:

1. Follow the process for testing oil
2. Obtain test results from Testing Lab
3. Fill vape cart with oil
4. In Metrc, **repackage the product** into a new package instead of using processing jobs
