| Reason: An update to processing jobs, allowing for excess waste weight to be recorded. | | |

Metrc is pleased to announce an update to recording waste weight for Processing Jobs, scheduled for release in late January.

Updated functionality




Figure 1: Confirmation when wasting a greater quantity than the total weight of the Processing Job




Figure 2: Alert that a Note must be included

This update allows licensees to record waste weights that exceed the total weight of the input materials used in a Processing Job - **see Figure 1 below**. When performing this action, the licensee is required to enter a note explaining the overage - **see Figure 2 below**.

Common scenarios where waste weight may exceed input weight include processes such as flower washing or infused edible production where additional non-cannabis materials or absorbed liquids are present.

By allowing waste overages with mandatory explanatory notes, this enhancement provides licensed businesses and regulators with improved transparency while removing workflow barriers.

API

For API users, the same capability will be available via the following endpoints:

- PUT /processing/v2/finish
- POST /processing/v2/createpackages
