Topic: Licensees must designate locations for immature plant batches in Maryland Metrc system.		

Greetings,

Metrc, in conjunction with the Maryland Cannabis Administration (MCA) is informing Standard Grower Businesses and Micro Grower Businesses that locations will be enabled to be tracked in Maryland Metrc for immature plant batches as of **August 25, 2026**.

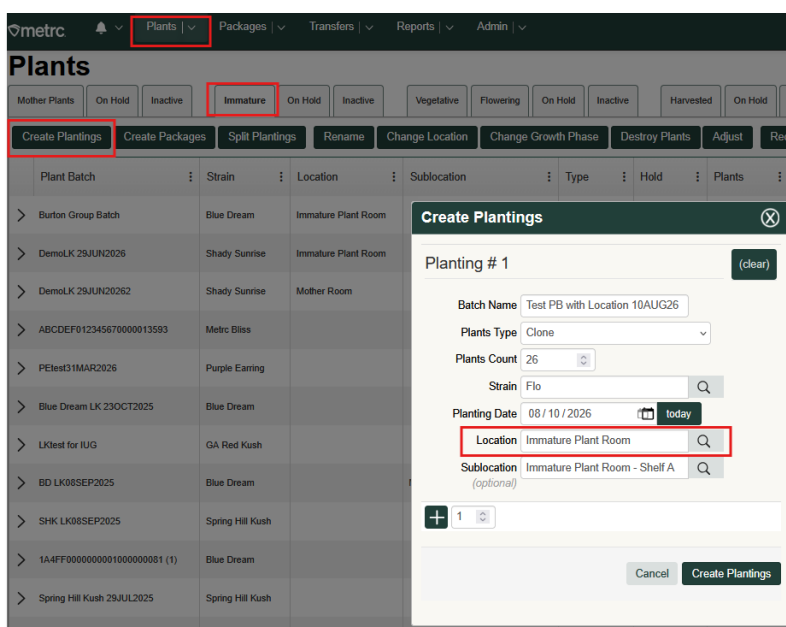


Figure 1: Create Plantings Action Window – Location Field is Now Required

To designate a location for your immature plant batch, navigate to Plants > Immature > Create Plantings. (A location must be created before it can be assigned.) The location field will be required to be completed. – **see Figure 1.**

Note: Sublocation is an optional field and may be used by licensees to designate location more granularly as desired. For more information about sublocations, see [MD IB #104](#).
