Greetings,

Metric in conjunction with the Nevada CCB would like to share the latest list of transfer types including the announcement of the newest transfer type available, **External – Seed Sale**.

This bulletin covers the following:

- Transfer Manifest Corrections
- External - Seed Sales

Transfer Manifest Corrections

If a correction to the dollar amount on a Transfer Manifest is needed, originating facilities may edit prices on wholesale transfer manifests for up to six (6) months from the date of creation without using a Virtual Transfer, **as long as no sales have been made off the package**.

All other transfer corrections (e.g., incorrect item or quantity on a Transfer Manifest) must be made through the Virtual Transfer process. **The initial transfer must be accepted in Metric before a Virtual Transfer is used to make the correction.** Virtual Transfers must not be used to change or correct the sending or receiving facility associated with a transfer.

Transfer errors must be documented in an internal error log, and all supporting documentation (including emails, invoices, and signed manifests) must be maintained on file and provided upon state request.

Please be reminded that all facilities are required to **verify and validate outgoing and incoming inventory within twenty-four (24) hours before confirming receipt** in the seed-to-sale tracking system.

External – Seed Sale

External – Seed Sale, new transfer type was implemented pursuant to **Senate Bill 168**, which authorizes licensed cultivation and production facilities to sell cannabis seeds to non-licensees both within and outside the State of Nevada. **When seeds are sold to persons located outside Nevada, the licensed facility is responsible for verifying that the receiving state permits the sale of cannabis seeds.**

Cannabis seed sales to state-licensed facilities must still be **tracked and recorded in the seed-to-sale system.**

Tax Note: If a seed sale transaction is a retail transaction, it is considered **taxable** and subject to [sales tax](#). The facility must collect sales tax at the point of sale and properly report and remit it to the **Nevada Department of Taxation**. Licensees should maintain documentation for all transactions and contact the [Department](#) with any questions regarding the taxability of specific transactions.

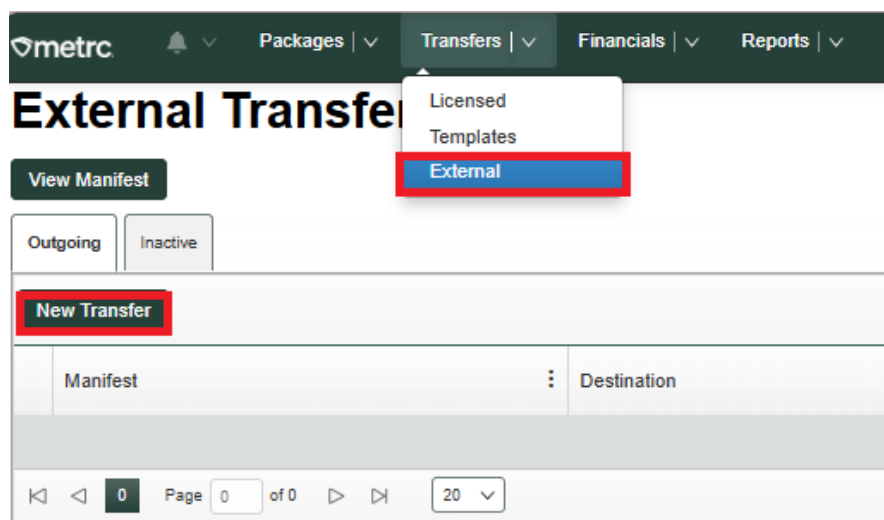


Figure 1: New External Transfer

This new transfer type will be registered using an “External Transfer”. To access this transfer type, please drill down into the “Transfers” menu and select “External”. To register the sale, you’ll go into “Outgoing” and “New Transfer” - **see Figure 1.**

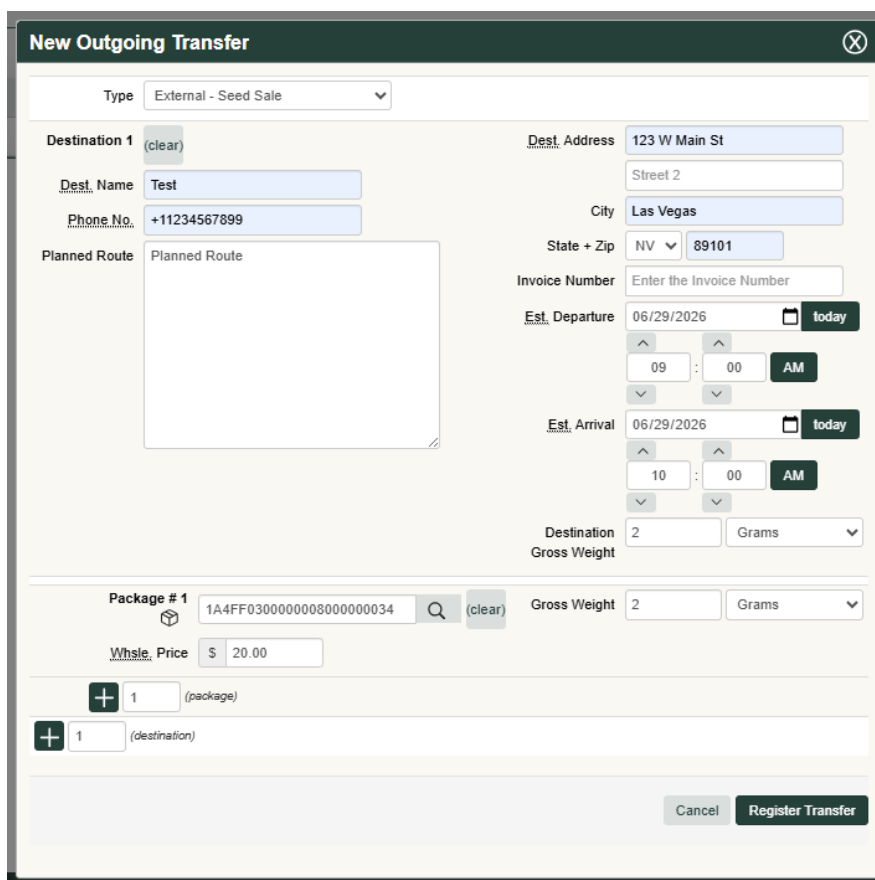


Figure 2: Reporting External - Seed Sale transfer

Select “External – Seed Sale” and enter all required transfer details, including the destination name, phone number of the designated person, planned route, address, estimated departure and arrival dates, destination gross weight, package, gross weight, and wholesale price. **See Figure 2.**

All Transfer Types

In addition to the Transfer Types previously listed in the [CCB Wholesale Transfer guidance](#), the complete and most current list of Transfer Types is provided below.

Transfer Type	Transaction Type	Description
Affiliate Wholesale Transfer- Initial	Wholesale	Used for the first wholesale sale of cannabis from a cultivation facility to an Affiliate Licensee. "Affiliate" means a person who, directly or indirectly through one or more intermediaries, controls, is controlled by or is under common control with, a specified person.
Compliance/Law Enforcement- External Transfer	Standard	Used only for seizure of cannabis products by CCB or law enforcement. A copy of the seizure notice must be kept on file, and an incident report must be filed with the CCB.
External - Patient Donation	Standard	Acquisition of usable cannabis donations from state-authorized patient cardholders. The patient's ID number must be valid in the State of Nevada.

Transfer Type	Transaction Type	Description
External - Seed Sale	Wholesale	A sale of cannabis seeds by a licensed cultivation or production facility to non-licensees.
External -Seed Acquisition	Standard	Authorized acquisition of cannabis seeds from external sources.
Identical Ownership Transfer-Cultivation to Cultivation	Standard	The transfer is to an identically owned cultivation facility and is not defined as a “wholesale transfer.” “Identical ownership” has a DISTINCTLY different meaning than “affiliate.”
Lab Transfer	Standard	Used only to transfer laboratory samples to and from a licensed laboratory.
Non-Affiliate Wholesale Transfer-Initial	Wholesale	Used for the first wholesale sale of cannabis from a cultivation facility to a Non-Affiliate Licensee. “Non-Affiliate” is any person that does not fall into the definition of “Affiliate.”
Product Packaging Temp Transfer-No Sale	Standard	Temporary transfer of usable cannabis or cannabis products for packaging purposes ONLY . All packaged inventory must be returned to the originating facility within 10 business days.
Remediation Temp Transfer-No Sale	Standard	Temporary transfer of usable cannabis for remediation or pre-treatment purposes ONLY . Inventory must be returned to the originating facility within 10 business days.
Virtual Transfer	Wholesale	Used to correct transfer variances AFTER receipt in Metrc. Transfer errors must be logged in an internal error log, and corresponding documentation (including emails, invoices, and signed manifests) must be kept on file and submitted upon state request.
Wholesale Return	Wholesale	Used to physically return cannabis products to the originating facility. The original transfer manifest should be attached or referenced as a note.
Wholesale Transfer-Subsequent	Wholesale	Used by production facilities or for transfers of cannabis products only after an initial transfer has been executed. Records of the initial transfer must be maintained.
